

The New Paltz UMC Board of Trustees is entrusted with the duty of safeguarding funds donated to the Church for a particular purpose determined by the donor. The Trustees have identified four donations received before 2005 that have not been used the purpose they were donated for. The funds are:

There is a fund for the purchase of acolyte robes. The robes are no longer used in the worship service. The amount is \$75.00.

There is a fund for the purchase of hand bells. There is a set of hand bells that have not been used recently. The amount is \$500.00.

There is a fund for the purchase of quiet room furnishings. There is currently furniture in the room. The amount is \$136.00.

The Minnie Duryea Fund was set up so that the interest earned could be used to purchase flowers for the altar during March which is the month of her birth. The principle is \$400.00 and it earned \$0.43 in 2023. Live flowers are no longer used as altar decorations.

We are looking for the original donors of these funds in order to have them available for other uses.
